

Course on Equality and Human Development Policy

Organized by the *Latin American University and Center for Human Economy of Uruguay*

The Latin American University and the Center for Human Economy of Uruguay (UECLAEH) are promoting a summer course on [Equity and Human Development Policy](#). It is an online course open to the Spanish-speaking world. It will take place in March – April 2025.

In this course, Jairo Morales Nieto explains the foundations of the new development paradigm and directs his reflections and analysis toward human development policy and its implementation in practice. He greatly values experimentation at the local and sectoral level in real time and achieving full employment as a fundamental step towards distributive economic equity and economic growth.

The course contains eight keynote lectures that share the same analytical unit whose central axis is the question of "equality" understood as a substantive philosophical ideal of the modern political economy whose adoption can reshape the essence of democratic market societies in the 21st century.

The course, which includes 18 total hours, will be held online. It will consist of synchronous classes through the Zoom platform and asynchronous activities on the UECLAEH online virtual campus. The Course will run between March 25 and April 29, 2025, with two weekly classes of two hours each.
