

## Starting collaboration between the Municipality of Naples and the KIP International School

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of July 2012, a Collaboration Agreement between the Municipality of Naples (Italy) and the KIP International School was finalized in Naples. The Agreement was signed by the Major Luigi De Magistris on behalf of the Municipality and by the President of the School Luciano Carrino.

The Municipal Councilor Sergio D'Angelo witnessed the signature, and he is in charge of ensuring the coordination of the Naples Municipality efforts.

The Agreement establishes the setting up of an office of the International School KIP in the city of Naples and the creation of a Joint Working Group, with the aim of defining

an action plan to be implemented over the next months.

In particular, the agreement foresees to implement initiatives that integrate the KIP School patrimony of knowledge and the relevant potentialities of the city and the regional territory, for building a new approach to the internationalization of development consistent with the objectives of the Millennium Platform of the United Nations. Joint initiatives are already underway for the identification of institutional and financial sponsors for the implementation of the work plan

The Municipality of Naples announced the forthcoming signature of the agreement with the School in the International Meeting *For Development without Poverty* held on 11 May 2012 in Rome, at the Chamber of Deputies of the Italian Parliament, with the participation of over 110 representatives of international cooperation and of the development world. The Municipality of Naples, in that occasion, offered also to host the international event planned by the School in 2013.
