The open event will showcase some of the innovative experiences from Africa and Latin America published by *Universitas Forum* in collaboration with the Huairou Commission, UN Habitat, IDRC and UN Women's MyDEL Programme in a special issue on the same topic. It will take place in on Wednesday, 5 September from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. at the Huairou Commission Exhibition Booth (Booth 120 in the World Urban Campaign area).
