CONFERENCE ORGANIZED BY GLOBAL DRYLAND ALLIANCE

On 14 September 2015, the conference *Desertification* and *Food Security: risks and opportunities* organized by <u>Global Dryland Alliance (GDA)</u> has been held in the KIP Pavilion at Expo 2015.

During the meeting, H.E. Abdulaziz bin Ahmed Al-Malki Al Juhani, Commissioner General of Qatar Pavilion, Qatar's Ambassador to Italy, has welcomed the GDA conference's attendees and pointed out the significant risks caused by dryland and its negative impact on the development process whereas it should be used where important agricultural potentials are available.

Participated in the forum were senior officials from the United Nations World Food Program, the Permanent Interstates Committee for Drought Control in the Sahel, the United Nations Framework Convention to Combat Desertification, the Islamic Development Bank group, and the International Centre for Biosaline Agriculture, and a number of experts.

The Global Dryland Alliance is an initiative on enhancing food security and tackling problems related to climate change in dryland countries launched by the State of Qatar in partnership with WFP, IDB Group, UNCCD, CILSS and ICBA.

Accelerated by climate change, the impact of desertification is already showing dramatic worldwide increase in the number of natural disasters, food









insecurity, forced migration and political instability. Today, there is a huge imbalance between the production and the consumption of food. To meet the common challenges of the planet, it is necessary that international organizations, countries, the private sector and NGOs work together to find the right solutions.
